Classroom Organization

Students will be in class cohorts again in the fall and they will stay in the same classroom all day. They will eat there too.

We have 3 grade 7 core French classes, 3 grade 8 core French classes, and one 7, one 8, and one 7/8 immersion classes.

Core French classrooms will have three teachers. One for French, one for music, one for all other subjects.

French Immersion classrooms will have either 2,3 or 4 teachers, depending on the teachers' schedules.
